

Installation Instructions

6021 – Rear Under Seat Tray for Syncro

Installation:

Step 1: First, open your rear seat base and lock it using the lever on the passenger side so it can't suddenly come smashing down onto your 'hot dog digits'.



Step 2: Next, drop in the tray and measure 4" down from the passenger side edge of the seat base to the top edge of the tray. Do this on the front and back to ensure it's at the same height.



Step 3: With the tray at the correct height and pulled tight to the front panel and passenger side of the seat base, install one of the provided truss-head screws in the front hole by using a #2 Philips head screwdriver (Do not use a drill!).



Step 4: Measure the rear again to make sure it's still 4" to the tray edge and install another screw in the rear hole to secure it in place. You can also now install the passenger side center screw as well.



Step 5: Now move to the driver's side of the tray, and simply flush it up to the top face of the inner wood panel of the heater cover as shown below. Install a screw to secure it in place and repeat the process in the rear followed by the middle screw.



That's it! You're done!



Note: This Tray includes an access panel that allows you to still be able to turn on or off the coolant control valve for the factory rear heater (not shown on these instructions). To remove the panel, simply unscrew the thumbscrew and remove the panel. Installation is the opposite of removal.
